Understanding Law and Grace

Grace and Law are not opposites

Law's purpose was to show us that we are under the reign of sin.

Romans 5:20-21.


Grace does not *replace* the law. LAW ---> GRACE

The reign of sin came about as a result of Adam's disobedience. The law was brought alongside to cause the reign of sin to abound. Grace nullifies the reign of sin. Therefore, grace does not replace the law. It makes the law unnecessary.

Grace frees us from the reign of sin.

Absolutely nothing is carried from the law into grace.

Romans 11:6, Galatians 2:16-21 (See next overlay)



How then DO we view the law properly in our practice? ----->>>



Interesting facts:

Only a true dispensationalist can free himself from confusing the law with grace.

- The Reformed/covenant elements must mix in Kingdom truth to gain desired obedience.
- The Arminian/charismatic elements must import Kingdom authority into their systems, again mixing law with grace.

- To show the unrighteous their sin. 1 Timothy
 1:9,10
- To illustrate divine truth. Leviticus 8
- To illustrate divine principles. Ephesians 6:1

The Nuts & Bolts Baptism & Adoption

SPIRIT BAPTISM

PROVIDES EQUAL ACCESS TO THE PROMISE

OF THE ABRAHAMIC COVENANT.

Galatians 3:22-26 (See also Romans 6)

This baptism assures

- (1) our identity in Christ,
- (2) our position in Christ,
- (3) our reciprocal union with Christ,
- (4) and our equal access to the promises!

Operative Words

Faith—Scan chs. 3 & 4

Promise—Scan chs. 3 & 4

Seed—Scan chs. 3 & 4

Spirit—3:2,5,14; 4:6,29; 5:5,16,17,18,22,25; 6:8,18

Spirit BAPTISM accesses the promise and activates Spirit Adoption.

Stoicheion

(Fundamental Premises, or A,B,C's)

Philosophical stoicheion are based on Gnosticism, Platonism & Aristotle.

Political stoicheion descend from Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, & Rome. (Daniel 2.)

Religious stoicheion all descend from works based thinking.

SPIRIT ADOPTION

Galatians 4:1-14

- (1) Frees us from bondage to the elements of the world. (stoicheion) 4:1-4
- (2) Redeems us unto the adoption of sons. 4:5
- (3) Frees the Holy Spirit to administer the Father-son relationship in us. 4:6
- (4) Gives us immediate access to the inheritance. 4:7
- (5) Demonstrates the insanity of returning to the bondage of the elements (stoicheion). Note: Col. 2:8,20



Notes on Circumcision

The Physical Aspects

Keynote Passage: Genesis 12; 17:1-21

- The physical location of the procedure symbolically relates to the transmission of seed.
 - This covenant is to Abraham and his Seed.

The Spiritual Aspects

And 30:1-6

Circumcision represents

War. Zero" in the flesh

heart at the Restoration.

The Mosaic Aspects

Keynote Passage: John 7:22


· Circumcision became associated with the Law of Moses
after Abraham.

The New Covenant Aspects

Keynote Passage: Romans 2:25-3:31; Galatians 5:1-6

 Interestingly, circumcision now represents "ground zero" in the war of flesh versus Spirit.

Note: Circumcision has absolutely NO connection with Christian baptism!



THE LOGICAL PROCESS IN THE MIND OF THE JEW

- We, the Jews are all sons (seed) of Abraham.
- We are all the children of promise through Isaac.
- We are secured through our covenant which was authenticated at Mt. Sinai.
- Jerusalem is the City of God.

THE LOGICAL PROCESS IN THE MIND OF GOD

K The promise was made to Abraham and his Seed (not seeds.). Therefore it is realized in Messiah. Only those who come through Messiah may now

realize the benefits of the Abrahamic Covenant*. Gal 3:16

ABRAHAM HAD TWO SONS

(and their spiritual conditions are <u>both</u> represented in Israel.)

- He had one son through the slave Hagar who represents bondage.
- As Ishmael was antagonistic toward Isaac, so the law and flesh are to life in the Spirit.
- The descendents of this bondage are represented by those who keep the law (or any other rudiment.)
- Mt. Sinai represents the sphere of their worship.
- The city of Jerusalem represents their quality of life.

- He had one son through a freewoman who represents liberty.
- The bondwoman and her son had to be cast out to end this antagonism.
- The descendents of this liberty are represented by those who are of faith and grace through Christ.
- The heavenly Mt. Zion represents their sphere of worship.
- The heavenly Jerusalem represents their city.

*CONSIDER HOW THIS RELATES TO CURRENT CONTEMPORARY ISSUES



- The promise was made to Abraham's Seed, and;
- We inherit that promise through Christ, then:

R

- 1.) The New Covenant is a subset of the Abrahamic Covenant and is *not* free standing, and;
- 2.) There is only one New Covenant for Jews and Gentiles alike, and;
- 3.) There is only *One* Householder and Administrator of that Covenant, our Messianic Priest.

If Statements $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ and $\underline{\mathbf{B}}$ above are true the following systems are erroneous:

Ultra Dispensationalism - which imagines two New Covenants!

Progressive Dispensationalism - which *blurs* **the function of the covenants.**

Revised Dispensationalism - which imagines a *temporary* New Covenant for the church!.

Reformed Theology - which *spiritualizes* the whole discussion away, ignoring the literality of the Abrahamic covenant and its subsequent expansions.



Sole Love

Putting our Spirit-led New Covenant Ministry in action! Gal 6:1-10

- {1} Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- {2} Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.
- {3} For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.
- {4} But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another. {5} For every man shall bear his own burden.
- (6) Let him that is taught in the word communicate unto him that teacheth in all good things.
- {7} Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. {8} For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. {9} And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
- {10} As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith.
